

Directions for consistent studying for bachelor and master degrees National Yunlin University of Science and Technology

1. To encourage excellent students in our university to continue study in the master degree programs of related institutes in our university and reach the goals of achieving continuous learning and shortening study period, these directions are stipulated.
2. Each department / institute in our university is may recruit pre-master student from undergraduates studying in our university. All 4-year system undergraduates in our university with study period at least 5 semesters (1 semester for 2-year system students) and conforming to the selection qualification of “stipulations for the selection of pre-master students” in each department / institute may complete application sheets and prepare transcripts of the past study periods, course planning, and etc. and send to each related department / institute for review after approved by department head. Pre-master student lists should be submitted to office of academic affairs to serve as reference by each department / institute before 1/31 in first semester and before 6/30 in second semester.

If a student is chosen as pre-master student by more than one department / institute, he or she shall choose one of the department or institute to check in before the specified date stipulated by our university and claim to give up the pre-master admission qualifications of other department / institute in written.
3. Each department and institute should provide pre-master students with joint counselling services to help students choose courses. The course choosing of students should be conducted according to the related provisions of our university.
4. Undergraduates selected to be pre-master students must get bachelor degree within the stipulated study period of our university and attend to the admission examination or normal admission examination of master degree program in our university. Once enrolled, said pre-master students officially obtain the qualifications of master degree program graduates in

our university.

5. “Selection committees for pre-master students” should be established if department or institute wants to enroll pre-master students. Department or institute head need to be member in committee and serve as convener. 2 to 4 members will be employed by convener and after passing affairs meeting, it will be sent to office of academic affairs to serve as references.
6. Graduate institutes about to enroll pre-master students need to stipulate “provisions for selection of pre-master students” according to this directions, which include the quota of places, selection qualifications, selection criteria, and etc. After reported to and approved by dean of said department or institute, provost, and principal, implementation will be allowed after announced by office of academic affairs.
7. After obtaining the qualifications of pre-master students, courses in master programs that undergraduates have studied and with grades no less than 70 will be recognized as the required credits in master degree program (excluding dissertation credit). However, if courses in graduate program have been taken into account for the graduation degree of undergraduates, it is not allowed to apply for transferring of credits into master degree programs.
8. Matters for which these directions do not provide shall be subject to other rules and regulations of our university and Ministry of Education
9. These regulations were approved by University Senate and submitted to principal for approval. Implementations were allowed after principal’s approval. Any amendment is thereto.
