

The Implementation of Inter-school Course Selection in National Yunlin University of Science and Technology

1. To promote cooperation between schools, sufficiently apply teachers and equipment, and facilitate students to take courses in other schools, these essentials were stipulated according to the Article 25 of Enforcement Rules of the University Act.
2. Students in our school could only choose the courses in other schools under the situations that said courses are not available in our school in that semester. Approvals from the department head in both schools are needed and the approval documents should be sent to office of academic affairs to serve as references.
3. The courses in other schools taken by undergraduates in our university should not exceed 1/3 of total credits of that semester (including the credits of inter-school curriculum, numbers after decimal points would be eliminated). The scores should be grand as total with other credits obtained in our university. The courses taken in our university and other schools should be limited within the limit credits. The inter-school credits of graduates should be confirmed by the department head. Total credits of inter-school courses should not occupy more than 1/3 of credits required for graduation.
4. Our university could charge for credits fees, internship fees and cost of materials from students from other schools who take inter-school courses in our university.
5. Students from other schools who choose inter-school courses in our university should comply with all regulations of the school.
6. Students from other schools who choose inter-school courses in our university should transact inter-school course-selecting procedures from the starting date of new semester to the deadline of registration and dropping out of courses. Overdue will not be accepted. After choose courses, dropping out and refunds will not be allowed unless the courses are canceled owing to

underrepresented student numbers.

7. Students from other schools who choose inter-school courses in our university and want to check their achievement tests should process according to the regulations of the school.
8. It is accepted by our university that students in other schools select courses in our university. The transcripts of students will be sent to their original schools after the end of each semester.
9. Application procedures for inter-school courses proposed by students in our university should be completed from the starting date of new semester to the deadline of registration and dropping out of courses. Overdue are not accepted. After choose courses, dropping out and refunds will not be allowed unless the courses are canceled owing to underrepresented student numbers.
10. If there is any agreement between our university and other partner schools about the cooperation of inter-school course selection, the agreements would be the references over these essentials.
11. These regulations were approved by University Senate and submitted to principal for approval. Implementations were allowed after principal's approval. Any amendment is thereto.
